



ERA 2 Housing Stability Services Application

Notice of Funding Availability under the HOME-ARP

Mississippi Home Corporation hereby notifies interested organizations of the availability of funds for the ERA 2 funds for Housing Stability Services. The purpose of ERA is to ensure that households at risk of homelessness can access and maintain safe housing with appropriate support services. ERA services are targeted towards those with low income (LI), households earning less than 80% of the area's median income. ERA assistance will be provided through approved Housing Stability Services.

Applying for Funding

1. The applicant is an eligible applicant.
2. The applicant is registered with sam.gov and provides a unique entity identifier (UEI).
3. The application is fully complete.
4. Nonprofits must submit proof of good standing with the Secretary of State for Mississippi.
5. Applicants were administered HUD housing-related grants through MHC within the last 24 months. MHC's housing related grants may include ESG, ESG-CV, HOPWA, HOME, or HOME-ARP.
6. The applicant must have a program-specific audit if they expended \$750,000 or more in Federal awards during the last fiscal year (CFR §200.501).
7. The applicant must be able to provide their audits, financial statements, and tax forms (IRS 990) for the last three years.
