2. Eligibility

- a. **Eligible Applicants.** General-purpose local government units and private nonprofit organizations with 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status, including faith-based agencies, are eligible for ESG services in all counties of Mississippi.
- b. **Eligible Use of Funds.** The Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG) Program provides funding for five eligible program components: Street Outreach, Emergency Shelter, Homelessness Prevention, Rapid Re-Housing, and the Homeless Management Information System (HMIS). These resources are used to identify and engage individuals and families experiencing homelessness, improve the quality and operation of emergency shelters, provide essential services to shelter residents, rapidly re-house households experiencing homelessness, and prevent individuals and families from becoming homeless.

3. Program Description

- a. **Goals and Objectives. Enhance Housing Stability & Homelessness Prevention Programs-** Reduce and prevent homelessness by strengthening housing stability and expanding supportive services. ESG funds will be used to provide wraparound services, including case management, employment assistance, transportation, education, and other eligible supportive services that help households obtain and maintain permanent housing. Housing stability plans will be required for all Homelessness Prevention participants to support long-term success. Applicants must partner with the Continuums of Care (CoCs) to coordinate ESG services.
