Notice of Funds Availability under the HOME Program for the Disaster Recovery Program

Mississippi Home Corporation announces the availability of \$300,000 in grant funds for the Disaster Recovery Program under the HOME Program to provide safe, decent, and affordable housing to low and very low-income homeowners. These funds will be used for the purpose of providing housing assistance to counties in declared area impacted by a disaster to help rebuild the community's housing stock and encourage the resettlement of displaced homeowners by reconstruction and rehabilitation of existing units or replacement of manufactured homes. Funds will aid households (individuals and families) whose annual gross income is at or below 80% of the area median income (AMI). The HOME program is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and is administered by Mississippi Home Corporation (MHC).

All counties are eligible to apply for Disaster Recovery funding through a non-competitive process after a state declared disaster. Applications will be reviewed according to the HOME Disaster Recovery program federal regulations.
