DUPLICATION OF SERVICES CERTIFICATION

Funding for rental and utility assistance requires that all grantees must ensure that there is no duplication of services in order to maximize all available resources. The grantees must ensure there are adequate procedures in place to prevent any duplication of benefits as required by section 312 of the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5155) and in accordance with section 1210 of the Disaster Recovery Reform Act of 2018 (division D of Public Law 115–254; 132 Stat. 3442), which amended section 312 of the Robert T. 2 Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 5155).

A duplication of benefits occurs when a person, household, business, government, or other entity receives financial assistance from multiple sources for the same purpose, and the total assistance received for that purpose is more than the total need for assistance.) HOME-ARP funds cannot be used to pay for eligible costs that have already been paid for, or will be paid for, by another Federal program, such as the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG-CV), HOME, Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERA) funds, Housing Opportunity for Persons With AIDS (HOPWA), Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) and CoC rental programs, insurance, or other sources. If this occurs, the funds must be repaid to the agency as applicable.

Tenants must provide a self-certification indicating that they have not received a duplicative benefit and listing potentially duplicative assistance that they have already received, or reasonably anticipate receiving, and through other means. This self-certification must be completed PRIOR to the provision of assistance.
