2. Eligibility

- a. **Eligible Applicants.** General-purpose local government units and private nonprofit organizations with 501(c)(3) tax-exempt status, including faith-based agencies, are eligible for HOPWA services in all counties of Mississippi.
- b. **Eligible Use of Funds.** The Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) Program provides housing assistance and supportive services to low-income individuals and families living with HIV/AIDS. HOPWA funds are used to provide tenant-based rental assistance, short-term rent, mortgage, and utility assistance (STRMU), permanent housing placement, supportive services, housing information, and resource identification. These resources help households obtain and maintain stable housing, improve access to medical care and supportive services,



increase housing stability, and reduce the risk of homelessness while improving health outcomes for persons living with HIV/AIDS.

3. Program Description

- a. **Goals and Objectives. Enhance Housing Stability & Homelessness Prevention Programs-** Improve housing stability, health outcomes, and quality of life for low-income individuals and families living with HIV. HOPWA funds will be used to provide housing assistance and supportive services that help eligible households obtain and maintain stable housing, increase access to healthcare, improve viral suppression and overall health outcomes, and reduce the risk of homelessness through coordinated housing and service delivery.
