Document Purpose:

The purpose of this document is to briefly articulate a spending plan for the State of Mississippi's HOPWA funds administered by Mississippi Home Corporation (MHC). These funds are intended to provide long-term comprehensive strategies for meeting the needs of low-income persons with AIDS or related diseases and their families.

Work Plan:

The following work plan identifies projects and services to which the State's HOPWA funds are committed or may be committed. MHC will garner new projects and services by releasing the HOPWA application to solicit proposals to fund activities approved in the AAQ such as TBRA, STRMU, supportive services, facility base housing, PHP, resource ID, construction, rehabilitation, acquisition, etc.

All activities undertaken in this spending plan will be executed in accordance with the AIDS Housing Opportunity Act, 24 CFR part 574, and Mississippi's Consolidated Plan.
