

## FY2025 NOTICE OF FUNDING AVAILABILITY (NOFA) Housing Trust Fund Program

Mississippi Home Corporation (MHC) announces the availability of funds for the Housing Trust Fund (HTF) Program for the development of rental housing. The HTF program is funded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and is administered by MHC.

HTF funds distributed by this notice are intended to leverage other affordable housing funds to maximize the resources available to develop affordable housing opportunities. Funded recipients must comply with maximum per-unit subsidy amounts, rent and income limits, property standards, and affordability periods.

## **APPLYING FOR FUNDING**

For-profit and non-profit applicants with experience developing affordable housing opportunities are eligible to apply for these funds. Applicants must demonstrate financial capacity and development experience directly relevant to the project submitted for funding.

Eligible projects are multifamily and single-family rental housing. Eligible activities are new construction and rehabilitation. Projects that include units serving (1) extremely low-income households (30% area median income) and homeless individuals, and (2) small households (single person or 1-4 persons) are especially encouraged to apply.

The maximum award amount is \$750,000 per project.
