Enhancing Mississippians' Lives In 2017

MHC provided affordable housing for 2,044 households across the state in 2017. Homes were financed through our Single Family Programs in 51 counties. MHC assisted individuals facing possible foreclosure with our Home Saver program, using Hardest Hit Funds, in 42 counties. MHC's Housing Tax Credit Program proved to be a boost to Mississippi's economy producing 1,030 jobs and \$42.2 million in wages for working families.

Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS

Provides housing assistance and related supportive services for low-income persons living with HIV/AIDS and their families.







HOME Funds

Provides funding for homebuyer assistance, homeowner rehabilitation, substantial rehabilitation of multifamily rental units, and new construction of multifamily rental units for very-low to low income Mississippians.



Emergency Solutions Grant

Provides services to persons experiencing homelessness or persons at risk of becoming homeless.

Housing Trust Fund

Provides funding to build, preserve, or rehabilitate the supply of rental housing for extremely low income Mississippians earning less than 30% of AMI.
