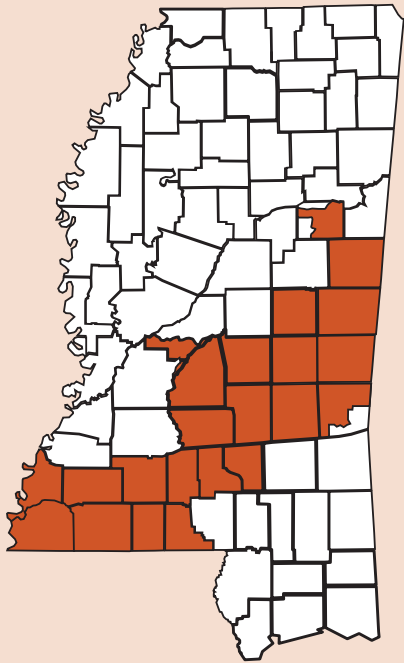


# Enhancing Mississippians' Lives In 2017

In 2017, Mississippi Home Corporation provided affordable housing for 460 households across the 24 counties located in District 3. Homes were financed through our Single Family Programs in 15 counties. MHC assisted individuals facing possible foreclosure with our Home Saver program, using Hardest Hit Funds, in 14 counties. MHC's Housing Tax Credit Program proved to be a boost to the economy in by producing 36 jobs and \$1.5 million in wages for working families.
