Temporary Relocation

- You will be moved to another unit (onsite or offsite) temporarily and **you will have the right to return.**
- Your rent and utility costs **will not increase** during your temporary relocation.
- You will receive assistance with your move and return.

Permanent Relocation

- You will **not** return to this property.
- You may be eligible for **financial assistance** to help you relocate to a **comparable, decent, safe, and sanitary (DSS)** dwelling.
- You will not be required to move with less than **90 days written notice.**

Relocation Assistance Available to You

You may be eligible for some or all of the following:

- **Advisory services** to help search for and secure housing
- **Moving expense payments** (actual cost or fixed schedule)
- **Payment of increased housing costs**, if applicable
- **Assistance locating comparable housing**
- **Language or accessibility accommodations**, if needed

Details about benefits, calculations, and eligibility will be provided during your relocation planning meeting.

Your Rights

- You **cannot** be required to move without written notice.
- You **will** have **at least 90 days** before any permanent move-out date.
- If temporarily relocated, you **will not** be charged higher rent or utilities.
- You have the right to **ask questions, request assistance, and appeal** decisions.
