



Mississippi Home Corporation Launches DPA14 Program

Mississippi Home Corporation (MHC) is now accepting reservations for the DPA14 program which is a partnership program with the Board of Supervisors in Coahoma, Tunica, and Washington counties.

The Boards of Supervisors in these counties received funds under the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and have authorized a portion of these funds to create additional down payment assistance for eligible households within their counties. The counties will work in conjunction with MHC by matching the MRB7 down payment of \$7,000, with an additional \$7,000, to provide a total of \$14,000 down payment assistance to households who meet the DPA14 program guidelines. This program will end April 30, 2026.



Important Program Features:

- Homebuyers must meet DPA14 income guidelines which differ from MRB income guidelines but cannot exceed MRB income restrictions.
- Property must be primary residence.
- Property must be located in one of the qualifying Mississippi counties: Coahoma, Tunica, or Washington
